

For an entry fee of \$5 (per ball), each participant will be entered into The Great Golf Ball

The drop to take place on July 2, 2011, at the City of Newcastle's Independence Celebration at Veterans Park. The maximum amount of balls to be sold is **1,000** – this gives you an excellent chance of winning.

Participants will be assigned a numbered golf ball(s) based on their purchase, and may enter multiple times.

On July 2, 2011, at approximately 6:13 p.m., the golf balls will be placed randomly in a bucket and dropped from a lift onto a target area. The first participant whose numbered golf ball goes into the hole will win the grand prize of **\$1,000** of Chamber Bucks to be spent locally.

1. If multiple balls go in the target area, the ball that is on the center mark will be determined the first place winner.
2. If no balls go in the hole, then the ball landing closet target area's center mark will be determined the winner. The ball closet target area's center mark will be determined by measuring from the center of the hole to the ball.
