Rules & Regulations

Overview:

The Newcastle Arts and Entertainment Council Art Contest – *Art and Soul* – is open to all students in grades 6-12 (public, private & home schools) and all adults age 18 and above. Categories include Sketching, Painting and Digital Art & Photography. Entry forms and fees must be post-marked to NAEC, PO Box 1092, Newcastle, OK 73065, or hand delivered to First National Bank and Trust, 1308 N. Main, Newcastle, by October 25, 2010. Awards will be given at the Great Pumpkin Fest on October 30, 2010. First through third places will be awarded in each category for each age division, as well as the people's choice selection. Winning works, along with all entries (space permitting), may be published in the Newcastle Pacer.

All contestants will receive a FREE admission wristband for the Great Pumpkin Fest and T.G. Farms Pumpkin Patch on October 30, 2010.

Rules

Entries must be original, flat works of art.

Maximum size of artwork is 24"x24", not including matting. Minimum size is 8"x10". Entries in all categories must be matted and submitted flat, not rolled or folded.

Entries must have the following information securely affixed to the back: Artist's name, school and grade (if applicable), mailing address, telephone and e-mail.

Entry forms and fees (\$16 for first work, \$10 for each additional entry) must be postmarked or hand delivered by October 25, 2010. Artwork must be delivered to the NAEC booth at the Great Pumpkin Fest no later than 10 a.m. Saturday, October 30, 2010.

By entering, the artist gives the Newcastle Arts and Entertainment Council permission to use his or her artwork for promotional, non-commercial purposes.

Judging

The entries will be judged by artists, teachers and laypeople from the Newcastle area. The judges will be looking at technical ability and creativity.

- Optional: Contestants may choose to attach a brief statement (50 words max.) about their medium, subject, interpretation, or any other information they feel is relevant to judging.

Awards

First, second and third places will be awarded in each age division in each of the three categories. Amount of cash prizes depend on the number of entries. The People's Choice Award will be given to the entry that receives the most monetary votes in its collection jar on the day of the exhibition. All awards will be presented at the Great Pumpkin Fest on October 30, 2010. Winners are not required to be present to win. News releases with names of the winners and photos of their work will be provided for submission to the local media.

Return of Artwork

Artwork may be picked up at the Newcastle Pacer after November 1, 2010. Artwork not picked up prior to December 1, 2010 will be kept as a donation to NAEC.
