Citizen

Criteria:

- Generally considered as a well-rounded community leader both professionally and personally
- Extended period of continuing service and community involvement endeavors that enhance the quality of life in the Newcastle service area.
- Dedicated service to the Chamber of Commerce through consistent support of Chamber events and activities.

Guidelines:

- Must be a current Newcastle Chamber of Commerce member or an associate/employee of a current member.
- Individual may not nominate self.
- May be eligible to win award once in a three year period.

Volunteer

Criteria:

- Dedicated service to the Chamber of Commerce through consistent support of Chamber events and activities.
- Dedicated service to the general community through consistent support of community endeavors that enhance the quality of place in the Newcastle area.

Guidelines:

- Must be a current Newcastle Chamber of Commerce member or an associate/employee of a current member.
- Individual may not nominate self.
- May be eligible to win award once in a three year period.

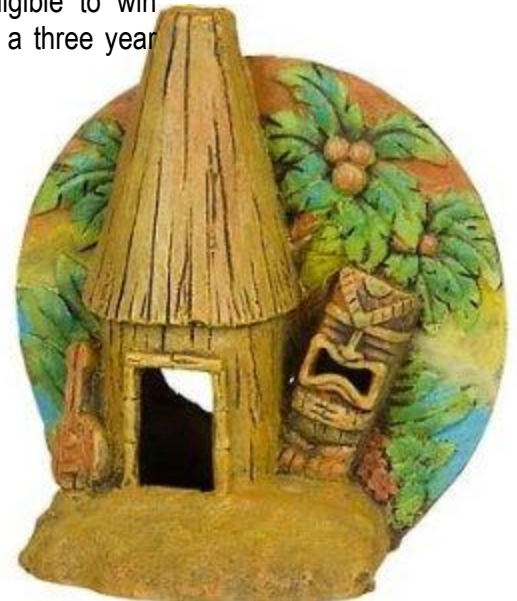

- Dedicated service to the general community through consistent support of community endeavors that enhance the quality of place in the Newcastle service area.
- Demonstrates a commitment to ethical business practices, employee support and development, involvement/leadership and utilizing resources in the Newcastle area to help your business grow.

Guidelines:

- Have 25 employees or less.
- Must be a current Newcastle Chamber of Commerce member for a minimum of two years.
- Have completed a minimum of three years in business.
- Businesses may nominate themselves.
- May be eligible to win award once in a three year period.

Large Business

Criteria:

- Building or product expansion that create a positive impact on the local business community by generating new jobs, increasing sales, or enhancing the aesthetic value of the property.
- Innovation of leading edge technology/services/products that enhance and advance business opportunities.
- Dedicated service to the Chamber of Commerce through consistent support of Chamber events and activities.
- Dedicated service to the general community through consistent support of community endeavors that enhance the quality of place in the Newcastle service area.
